The Haifa Center for German and European Studies (HCGES) invites applications from Master students and PhD candidates to present their research in a poster presentation during **Europe Day at the University of Haifa on Thursday, May 16**. The aim of the poster session is to inform the participants of Europe Day about current research projects on the topic of “Migration and the European Union”. This year’s theme of Europe Day is Migration and the European Union. As migration studies is an interdisciplinary field, research topics for the posters can include refugees, integration, policy making, securitization, populism, environmental migration, etc.

Posters of successful applicants will all be presented in an open space during the poster session. During the time of the event, you will be present at your poster and available for questions. Participants of Europe Day, including EU diplomats, (inter)national academics and high school students, will be moving around freely and look at and learn from the posters. You are welcome to prepare additional hand-outs, business cards or similar materials that you might spread on demand.

Applications should include **a project title and a short abstract** (max. 300 words). Please also state how you are affiliated with the HCGES or the CGS.

The application deadline is April 16, 2019.

The posters have to be received no later than April 28, 2019 in order to be printed timely.
