Poster Session

“Migration and the European Union”

For the size of the poster, you should choose an A0-Format (841 x 1189 mm). We recommend drafting your poster in a high (portrait) size.

If this is your first poster presentation, we have some additional information for you:

The aim is to quickly convey the first impression of your topic, methods, and results, so interested participants can approach you to deepen and exchange the first impressions in a personal talk.

Please avoid creating your poster too text-heavy in order to allow for quick capture of your project.

You should appropriate text in short and distinct chunks, which you can emphasize by the help of frames. Please use a neutral background in order to increase readability.

You can use visuals, i.e. photographs, a facsimile of documents, drawings and pictures, graphs and charts.

Visuals and text should be arranged in a meaningful way and support each other. You may like to interconnect different text chunks and graphic elements with the help of connecting lines or arrows.

You might use e.g. PowerPoint to create the poster. There it is possible to adapt the size of the slides to the desired size of the poster and create the slides accordingly.

We recommend you noting your name and email-address on some clearly visible spot on the poster.
