Filmed over three years, WATANI: MY HOMELAND tells the epic story of one family's escape from war-torn Syria and their attempt to make a new life in Germany. The children of Free Syrian Army Commander Abu Ali live on the frontline of civil war in Aleppo, the only family living in a derelict war zone that was once a busy residential neighbourhood. After Abu Ali is captured by ISIS the family is forced to flee their homeland and start a new life in a small, medieval town in Germany.
