

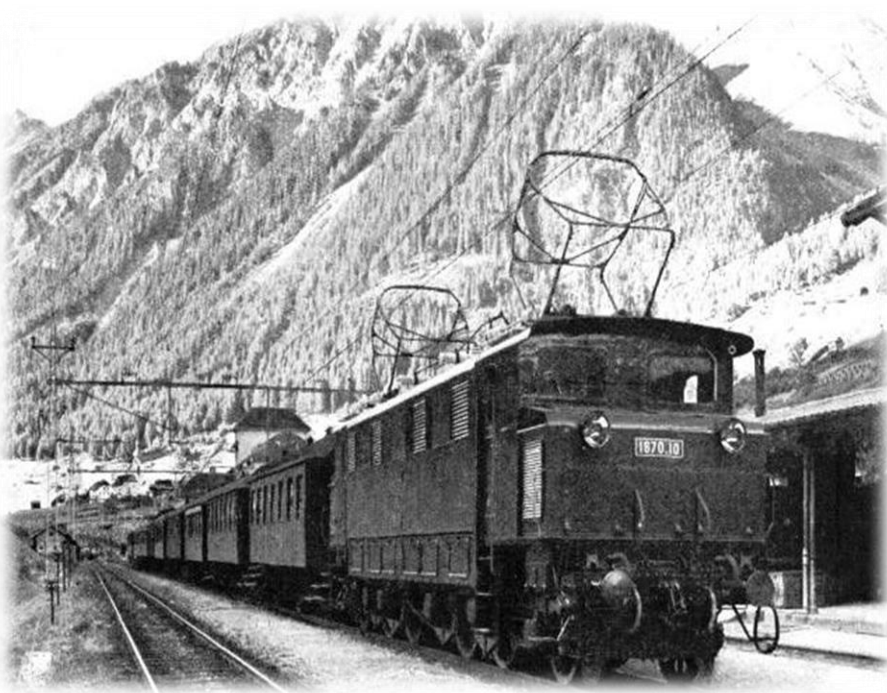

Researching Nazi Crimes: The Austrian Federal Railways as a Case Study

The topic of the lecture is the role of the railway in Nazi Germany. The focus is on the involvement of railway workers in Nazi crimes, e.g. occupation and forced labor, and the Holocaust. These topics are discussed on the example of the Austrian Federal Railways in the Deutsche Reichsbahn, the German Reich Railways.

In addition to historical introductions to new findings about these topics, the lecture deals also with the process of researching this specific case. It is therefore also an input for discussion of the design and development of research projects on Nazi crimes, as well as challenges and obstacles of such projects, especially when connected to still-existing companies.
