After attaining his Ph.D in History, Prof. Ivan Ilchev was member at the Faculty of History as Assistant Professor from 1978-1987. Later he became Associate Professor at the Sofia University and taught Early Modern and Modern History of the Balkan Peoples. He also acted as a visiting professor and lecturer for a number of leading universities and participated in numerous conferences. Among others at: Ohio State University (Columbus, USA); Maryland State University (College Park, USA); Woodrow Wilson Center (Washington, USA) and Chiba University (Japan). Furthermore Prof. Ilchev is the author of numerous articles, reviews, popular science film scripts and monographs.

From 2003 to 2007 Prof. Ilchev was the Dean of the History Department at the Sofia University and Member of the Academic Council. In 2007 Prof. Ilchev became Rector of the Sofia University.
